Contractor Fraud





Check for a permanent place of business, telephone number, and tax I.D. number.







Obtain and check client references. Hire a contractor with a good history.



Verify the contractor is licensed (if required) and bonded.







Get several written bids for work. A scammer will find problems that don't exist.



A contractor should never ask you to pay all costs upfront or require cash only!



Avoid door-to-door contractors. Honest contractors get business from happy client referrals.
